Enclosed for filing with the Commission are the following documents in Amendment of EMEX, LLC's Application for License as an Electric Generation Supplier.

- 1) Copies of the supplier licenses held by EMEX in the states other than Pennsylvania, as noted in Section 8.a. of the Application. (See Attachments 8.a.1 through 8.a.9)
- 2) A modified Appendix I to the application that includes responses to questions 8 and 9.

Please also consider this letter a request to permit the original bond in the amount of \$10,000, now in the possession of the Commission at Docket Nos. A-2010-2179537 and M-2019-3006865, to be used for purposes of this application. As noted in the Application, EMEX filed a Petition for Reconsideration of a Commission Order at those Dockets, revoking its license for failure to furnish appropriate financial security, and as part of its Petition for Reconsideration, EMEX provided the original bond as evidence of the fact that it had continuously maintained appropriate security. To the extent that the Commission grants reconsideration, the Commission can simply retain that bond and EMEX will withdraw the instant application as moot. However, in the event the Commission denies the Petition for Reconsideration, EMEX would request that said bond be transferred to this docket. If the Commission determines that EMEX must obtain a new bond for the pending application, EMEX requests that the Commission advise it of that determination as soon as possible so as not to delay its procurement of same.

L PRELIMINARY MATTERS

On July 21, 2010, EMEX Power, LLC ("Applicant") filed a verified application with the Illinois Commerce Commission ("Commission") requesting a certificate of service authority to operate as an agent, broker or consultant ("ABC") in Illinois pursuant to Section 16-115C of the Public Utilities Act ("Act"), 220 ILCS 5/1-101 et seg., and 83 III. Adm. Code 454 ("Part 454"). The Administrative Law Judge requested clarification of certain matters contained in the Application. The Applicant filed a verified response providing the required organizational chart. Applicant requests authority to offer services as an ABC for the procurement or sale of retail electricity supply for third parties in the State of Illinois.

11. REQUIREMENTS FOR ALL APPLICANTS UNDER SECTION 16-115C OF THE ACT

Applicant is a business organized under the laws of Texas and licensed to transact business in Illinois. Applicant has certified that it will comply with all applicable regulations; that it will comply with informational and reporting requirements established by Commission rule; that it will comply with informational and reporting requirements pursuant to Section 16-115C of the Act; and that it will comply with all other applicable laws, regulations, terms, and conditions required to the extent they have application to the services being offered by an ABC. Applicant has agreed to ensure that any person who acts on its behalf will comply with all applicable sections of Part 454. Applicant agrees that it will remain in compliance with the provisions of the Act and Part 454, and will ensure that authorizations received from customers, and all other applicable records are retained for a period of not less than three calendar years after the calendar year in Applicant has agreed to adopt and follow rules and which they were created. procedures to preserve the confidentiality of its customers' data.

III. FINANCIAL, TECHNICAL, AND MANAGERIAL REQUIREMENTS OF SECTION 16-115C

Pursuant to the requirements of Section 454.80 of Part 454, Applicant provided a surety bond in the amount of \$5,000 issued by a qualifying surety authorized to transact business in Illinois. Applicant submitted an original surety bond in satisfaction of Section 454.80.

Applicant is required by Part 454.60 to demonstrate that it meets the managerial qualifications necessary to provide services as an ABC. Applicant must further provide an organizational chart that indicates the position of persons which satisfy the managerial qualification. Applicant has demonstrated that it meets the managerial qualifications set forth in Part 454.60, as demonstrated in Attachment A. The response to the Administrative Law Judge contains an exhibit containing a corporate organizational chart and identifying the persons who are being used to meet the requirements of Part 454.60(a). Attachment A includes an exhibit containing occupational background information on the person or persons who are being used to meet the requirements of Part 454.60(a).

Applicant is required by Part 454.70 to demonstrate that it meets the technical qualifications necessary to provide services as an ABC. Applicant has demonstrated that it meets the technical qualifications set forth in Part 454.70 with the information provided, including the information included in Attachment A. Attachment A includes an exhibit containing occupational background information on the person or persons who are being used to meet the requirements of Part 454.70(a).

Applicant further agrees to comply with the Code of Conduct for ABCs contained in Section 454.90.

IV. COMMISSION CONCLUSION AND CERTIFICATE OF SERVICE AUTHORITY

The Commission has reviewed the application and attachments along with the supplementary information provided by Applicant regarding the technical and managerial requirements and all other requirements of the Act and Part 454 and finds that the Applicant sufficiently demonstrates compliance with the requirements.

The Commission concludes, therefore, that Applicant's request for a certificate of service authority to operate as an ABC in Illinois should be granted and should include the following authority:

CERTIFICATE OF SERVICE AUTHORITY

IT IS CERTIFIED that EMEX Power, LLC is granted service authority to operate as an agent, broker or consultant for the procurement or sale of retail electricity supply for third parties in the State of Illinois.

V. FINDINGS AND ORDERING PARAGRAPHS

The Commission, having reviewed the entire record, is of the opinion and finds that:

- (1) EMEX Power, LLC, a business organized under the laws of Texas, seeks a certificate of service authority to operate as an agent, broker or consultant under Section 16-115C of the Act;
- (2) the Commission has jurisdiction over the party hereto and the subject matter hereof;
- (3) the recitals of fact and conclusions reached in the prefatory portion of this Order are supported by the record and are hereby adopted as findings of fact:
- (4) Applicant has demonstrated that it possesses sufficient financial, managerial and technical resources and abilities to provide services as an agent, broker or consultant for the procurement or sale of retail electricity supply to third parties in the State of Illinois;
- (5) Applicant has complied with Section 16-115C of the Act and Part 454; and
- (6) EMEX Power, LLC should be granted the certificate of service authority to operate as an agent, broker or consultant as specified in this Order.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Illinois Commerce Commission that EMEX Power, LLC is hereby granted a Certificate of Service Authority authorizing it to operate as an agent, broker or consultant; said Certificate of Service Authority shall read as that set forth in Section IV of this Order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that EMEX Power, LLC shall comply with all applicable Commission rules and orders now and as hereafter amended.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, subject to the provisions of Section 10-113 of the Public Utilities Act and 83 III. Adm. Code 200.880, this Order is final; it is not subject to the Administrative Review Law.







ELECTRIC SUPPLIER CERTIFICATE

This 15th day of May 2012, the Commission determines and orders the following:

WHEREAS, on April 18, 2012, EMEX Power, LLC d/b/a Energy Market Exchange ("EMEX" or the "Company") filed an application seeking certification as a retail electric supplier in order to broker the sale or purchase of Electric Supply Service¹ (the "Application"). See 26 Del. C. §§1001(3), 1001(14), and 1012. Under the Electric Utilities Restructuring Act of 1999 (the "Act"),² "Electric Suppliers," which include Brokers, are not "public utilities," and, accordingly, the resulting sales of Electric Supply Service to Retail Electric Customers are not subject to traditional forms of rate regulation. See 26 Del. C. §§102(2) and 202(f);³ and

WHEREAS, in its Application, the Company states that it is a Broker that will utilize appropriate energy procurement strategies to meet the needs of commercial customers in Delaware. Staff reports

that the Company's Application fulfills all of the requirements for an Electric Supplier Certificate to act as a Broker as set forth in the Commission's Rules for Certification and Regulations of Electric Suppliers, 26 Del. Admin. C. §3001 (the "ES Rules"). In particular, Staff reports that the Company appears to possess the financial, operational, managerial, and technical capabilities to operate as a Broker of electric supply service. Therefore, Staff recommends that the Commission issue to EMEX an Electric Supplier Certificate that authorizes it to broker sales and customer purchases of Electric Supply Services in the State of Delaware, consistent with the scheme adopted by the Act and the ES Rules;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE AFFIRMATIVE VOTE OF NOT FEWER THAN THREE COMMISSIONERS:

- 1. That EMEX Power, LLC d/b/a Energy Market Exchange (the "Company") is hereby granted, under 26 Del. C. §1012(a) and 26 Del. Admin. C. §3001, a certificate ("Certificate") to do business and operate as an "Electric Supplier" (Broker) within the State of Delaware. Under this Certificate, the Company is authorized to broker Electric Supply Service within this State in accordance with 26 Del. C. Ch. 10.
- 2. That the Company shall at all times provide its brokerage of Electric Supply Service in accordance with the requirements imposed by 26 Del. C. Ch. 10 and 26 Del. Admin. C. §3001 as presently adopted, or as may be hereafter amended or supplemented. The Company is hereby notified that a violation of any applicable statute, rule, or other controlling authority may be enforced by the sanctions

permitted by 26 Del. C. §§1012(a) and 1019 and 26 Del. Admin. C. §3001-10.2.

- 3. That the Company shall file, pursuant to the provisions of 26 Del. C. §1012(c) (2) and 26 Del. Admin. C. §§3001-3.9 and 3.10, such reports and pay such fees and assessments as may be required or imposed by 26 Del. C. §§114 and 115.
- 4. That the Company consents to the jurisdiction of the courts of the State of Delaware for all acts or omissions related to its offering of Electric Supply Services in this State.
- 5. That the Company is hereby placed on notice that the costs of the proceedings will be charged to it under the provisions of 26 $Del.\ C.\ \S114(b)\ (1)$.
- 6. That the Commission reserves the jurisdiction and authority to enter such further Orders in this matter as may be deemed necessary or proper.

I. SUMMARY

In this Order, we license EMEX, LLC (EMEX) d/b/a Energy Market Exchange and EMEX Power to operate as a competitive electricity provider furnishing aggregator/broker services to the non-residential customer classes throughout Maine pursuant to Chapter 305 of the Commission's Rules.

II. APPLICATION AND DECISION

On April 17, 2012, EMEX applied to the Commission to operate in Maine as a competitive electricity provider pursuant to Chapter 305. EMEX proposes to provide aggregator/broker services to the non-residential customer classes throughout Maine. EMEX met all the Chapter 305 filing requirements. As a licensed competitive electricity provider, EMEX is required to comply with all applicable requirements and regulations, including all conditions of licensing, customer protection rules, and the filing of annual reports.

Pursuant to a Delegation Order dated April 23, 2008 in Docket No. 2008-185, PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION, Delegation of Authority to License Competitive Electricity Providers, the Commission delegated to the Director of Technical Analysis the authority under 35-A M.R.S.A., § 3203 (1)(2) and Chapter 305, §2 to license competitive electricity providers. On September 12, 2009, in Docket No. 2009-260, statutory changes took effect that change the title of this position. P.L. 2009, ch. 122. The Director of Technical Analysis will be the Director of Electric and Gas Utility Industries. All existing delegation orders that delegate Commission authority to the Director of Electric and Gas Utility Industries.

Accordingly, it is

ORDERED

- 1. That EMEX, LLCX d/b/a Energy Market Exchange and EMEX Power is hereby issued a license to operate as a competitive electricity provider pursuant to Chapter 305 of the Commission's Rules, to provide aggregator/broker services to the non-residential customer classes throughout Maine; and
- 2. That this license is effective on the date of this Order and valid until revoked or suspended by the Commission pursuant to section 3(A)(4) of Chapter 305, or abandoned by the licensee pursuant to sections 2(D)(10) and 2(D)(11) of Chapter 305 of the Commission's Rules.

- 2. <u>Appeal of a final decision</u> of the Commission may be taken to the Law Court by filing, within 21 days of the date of the Order, a Notice of Appeal with the Administrative Director of the Commission, pursuant to 35-A M.R.S.A. § 1320(1)-(4) and the Maine Rules of Appellate Procedure.
- 3. Additional court review of constitutional issues or issues involving the justness or reasonableness of rates may be had by the filing of an appeal with the Law Court, pursuant to 35-A M.R.S.A. § 1320(5).

This is to confirm that the New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission (Commission) has received EMEX, LLC d/b/a Energy Market Exchange and EMEX Power (EMEX)'s notice of intent to provide electric aggregation service in the State of New Hampshire, pursuant to New Hampshire Administrative Rules Puc 2003.05. Staff has reviewed the application provided and believes that it meets the requirements of Puc 2003.05. Based on Staff's recommendation and the Commission's review, the Commission approves EMEX's application to provide electric aggregation service in New Hampshire.

Please note the following provision of Puc 2003.05 (f): "[E]ach approved aggregator shall renotify the commission after the initial 2 year period, or after the 5 year renewal period as applicable, by filing with the commission an application for renewal at least 60 days prior to the expiration of the currently effective registration." Therefore it is required to refile an up-to-date written notice on or before April 29, 2014 if it continues to offer and provide electric aggregation service. In addition, EMEX is subject to the provisions of Puc 2004.03, telephone solicitation of customers, and Puc 2004.08, customer protections provided by aggregators. Finally, aggregators must comply with the requirements set out in RSA 362-F relative to the renewable portfolio standard (RPS) and RSA 362-F relative to disclosure of electric service energy sources and environmental characteristics. Please refer to Puc 2500 for further details regarding RPS reporting requirements. Commission Order No. 25,264 provides guidance as to the appropriate format for environmental disclosure.
