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SECTION 1  
RULES & REGULATIONS

**ITEM 10 - GOVERNING PUBLICATIONS**

For rates, rules, regulations and provisions applicable to the transportation of household goods, in use, except as otherwise specifically provided herein, see Tariff Freight Pa. P.U.C. No. 53 (Carrier Directory No. 53), loose-leaf revisions thereto and successive issues thereof, issued by Tristate Household Goods Tariff Conference, Inc., Agent.

**ITEM 20 - CLASSIFICATION OF PROPERTY**

Class 1 shipments are person effects and property used or to be used in a dwelling when a part of the equipment or supply of such dwelling and such other similar property: except that this subparagraph shall not be construed to include property moving from a factory or store, except such property as the householder has purchased with the intent to use in his dwelling and which is transported at the request of, and the transportation charges paid to the carrier by the householder.

**ITEM 30 - DECLARED VALUE**

Rates and charges named herein applicable when the value declared by shipper does not exceed sixty (60) cents per pound, per article. For method of determining rates when declared value exceeds sixty (60) cents per pound, per article, see Governing Tariff.

**ITEM 40 - ADDITIONAL EXPENSES**

Any parking fees incurred at the client's origin or destination will be the responsibility of the client and added to the carrier's charges.

Reservations made for services two (2) or fewer calendar days before the scheduled service date will be subject to an additional \$10.00 charge.

Reservations made for the same calendar day as when services are rendered will be subject to an additional \$15.00 charge.

**ITEM 50 - ADVANCE RESERVATIONS**

Advance reservations must be made prior to the service being rendered.

Refer to ITEM 40 for additional expenses incurred for reservations without sufficient advanced notice.

Abbreviations, reference marks and symbols are explained on last page of tariff.

SECTION 2  
ADDITIONAL SERVICES

Rates and charges for Additional Services in this section are in addition to all other rates in this tariff.

Containers to be supplied by shipper or purchased by shipper from 3rd Party vendor.

If Packing/Unpacking labor is requested by shipper, charges will be based on the hourly rates described on Page 4 of this tariff.

If a scheduled service is cancelled with less than two (2) days notice, shipper will be charged a cancellation fee equal to one (1) hour for each truck, move lead/driver, and individual mover that were to be assigned to the move.

Abbreviations, reference marks and symbols are explained on last page of tariff.

**SECTION 3  
HOURLY RATES**

Subject to Notes 1 to 6 below, the transportation charges on any shipment shall be a COMBINATION of the applicable TRAVELING CHARGE named in Column 1 plus HOURLY CHARGE at applicable rates named in Columns, 2, 3 and 4.

Hourly rates apply from the time of arrival to first point of origin (continued during all loading, transportation from first point of origin, as well as any extra stops, to final destination & unloading and dismissal of vehicle and men by shipper at destination).

NOTE 1 - Traveling charges (Column 1) are in addition to hourly rates (Columns 2, 3, and 4).

NOTE 2 - Hourly rates (Columns 2, 3, and 4) are based on the day or days as indicated, during which services are performed.

NOTE 3 - Hourly rates (Columns 2, 3, and 4) are billed in 15 minutes increments, rounding up to the nearest 15 minutes increment.

NOTE 4 - Peak rates (columns 2, 3, and 4) apply for moves performed the first 7 days of the calendar month and the last 7 days of the calendar month.

NOTE 5 - Minimum total transportation charges: Two (2) hours at rates named in Columns 1, 2, 3, and 4, as applicable.

NOTE 6 - Rate for each Move Lead and Additional Mover(s) will be computed from time of arrival at the first point of origin until completion of unloading and dismissal of vehicle and workers at final destination.

NOTE AA - Travel charge is a flat charge of \$99.00 per move.
