Dear Judge Watson:

An initial telephonic hearing was held on November 7, 2019 at 10 a.m. This letter is in response to a request you made during the hearing for further explanation on why 2 exhibit items should be admissible. You requested I respond within 10 days. The exhibits in question are E 41-47 (Statement by Director of National Intelligence before the House) and A 37-39 (Statement by the United States Access Board concerning report on the Indoor Environmental Quality Project).

The United States Access Board is an independent federal agency. This means it exists outside the federal executive departments and does not report to the executive. The Office of the Director of National Intelligence is also an independent federal agency which integrates the intelligence gathering and analysis functions performed across the intelligence community to provide intelligence to decision makers.

Both of these exhibits are considered records or statements of a public office. An exception to the hearsay rule for public records is covered by 42 Pa.C.S.A. § 6104.
