

**SECTION 1
RULES & REGULATIONS**

▲ ITEM 10 - SCOPE OF CARRIER'S OPERATING AUTHORITY

To transport, as a motor carrier, household goods in use, between points in Pennsylvania - PA P.U.C. Certificate No. A-00111047.

ITEM 20 - GOVERNING PUBLICATIONS

For rates, rules, regulations and provisions applicable to the transportation of HOUSEHOLD GOODS and RELATED ARTICLES, IN USE, except as specifically provided herein, see Tariff Freight Pa. P.U.C. No. 53 (Carrier Directory), revisions thereto and reissues thereof, issued by Tristate Household Goods Tariff Conference, Inc., Agent.

ITEM 30 - DECLARED VALUE

Rates and charges named herein applicable when value declared by shipper does not exceed 60 cents per pound per article. For method of determining rates when declared value exceeds 60 cents per pound per article, see governing tariff.

▲ ITEM 40 - FULL VALUE PROTECTION (#)

When a shipment is moved with Full Value Protection (FVP) coverage, a value must be declared by the Shipper on the Bill of Lading for the entire shipment. ITEM 60 - DEBRIS REMOVAL (#)

When shipper requests carrier to deliver packing material prior to the move, a flat charge of \$40.00 will be assessed in addition to other charges herein.

When shipper requests carrier to shrink wrap the furniture specified in this item, the following charges will be assessed in addition to other charges herein.

A charge of \$60.00 will be assessed for each forty (40) foot zone. Should customer choose to secure the parking permit themselves, but fail to do so, the customer will be responsible to pay any parking tickets or related fees received by the carrier.

ITEM 100 - BULKY ARTICLES (#)

When the articles specified in this item are a part of a household goods, in use, shipment, they will be subject to the applicable flat charge per item in addition to other charges named herein.
