Dear Ms. Chiavetta,



I greatly appreciate you taking the time to read this letter. I would be happy to meet with you any time to discuss this further.

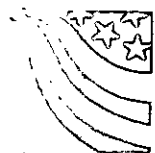
