Dear Secretary Chiavetta,

Please withdraw the Petition of Virgin Mobile USA, L.P. d/b/a Assurance Wireless ("Assurance") for Modification of Lifeline Service Offering that was filed on October 28, 2019 at Docket No. P-2010-2155915.

On November 19, 2019, the FCC issued an Order setting the broadband MSS at 3.0 GB per month effective Dec. 1, 2019,¹ down from the previously announced 8.75 GB MSS.² Assurance does not intend to implement a charge for Lifeline handsets to customers at this time and therefore the Petition is moot.

Consistent with the FCC's Nov. 19 Order, Assurance has increased its broadband Lifeline offer to include 3.0 GB of data per month for all new and existing customers. In addition, all new and existing Assurance Lifeline customers are receiving a limited time promotional offer of an additional 5.75 GB of broadband data, free of charge.
