

Status Report of Complainant Jeffrey W. Arndt's Amended Formal Complaint

In accordance with the updated Interim Order that was revised on October 11, 2019, I will explain in detail the status report thus far:

1. As of today, November 30, 2019, I am in the process of discussing a possible settlement with the Respondent.

2. The attorney for Respondent and I have been in good-faith communication. I have agreed to a telephonic hearing. In the event that the settlement does not finalize, I reserve the right to an in-person hearing. We have agreed upon the dates of February 24-28 to schedule a hearing.

3. This time of year is very busy for me with family and work. I have family visiting from out of state and numerous holiday events and work related deadlines. As I stated before, in the case of Pro Se litigants such as myself, I am limited in ability to draw upon any legal advantages. I refer to the mission statement of the PA PUC where it states, "The Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission balances the needs of consumers and utilities".

4. On November 27, 2019, I notified the attorney for the Respondent that I agree with the settlement agreement and I am ready to sign it. However, since the Respondent has asked that my wife also sign the settlement agreement's final page, and since there has recently been edits to the text of the settlement agreement, she has requested a few extra days to review it. Due to the recent holiday week with family, she has not had the chance to finish reviewing it. As soon as she makes her decision, I will be in touch with the attorney for the Respondent.


