RESPONDENT'S THIRD STATUS REPORT

Pursuant to the Presiding Administrative Law Judge's Interim Order Requiring Filing of Status Reports and Prehearing Motions ("Interim Order"), Respondent Duquesne Light Company ("Duquesne Light") submits this status report:

1. Pursuant to the Interim Order, Duquesne Light contacted its witnesses to determine their availability for a hearing on any two consecutive dates in February 2020.

2. Duquesne Light's witnesses are available for a hearing on two consecutive dates from February 17-21, 2020 and February 24-28, 2020, assuming that the Presiding ALJ does not schedule other pending cases involving Duquesne Light on these dates.

3. Duquesne Light requests a telephonic hearing.

4. Duquesne Light contacted Complainant to determine his availability for a hearing on any two consecutive dates in February 2020.

5. Complainant informed Duquesne Light that he is available for a hearing from February 24-28, 2020. Complainant further stated that he requests a telephonic hearing at this time because the parties have been engaged in ongoing settlement discussions. However, Complainant informed Duquesne Light that he prefers an in-person hearing if the parties do not ultimately settle the case.

6. Duquesne Light can confirm that the parties have been engaged in ongoing, good-faith settlement discussions.

7. If Duquesne Light does not file a dispositive motion or if its motion is denied, Duquesne Light respectfully requests that any new scheduling order provide that the parties submit exhibits and exhibit lists approximately six weeks prior to the hearing date.
