Dear Secretary Chiavetta:

In accordance with the Interim Order issued by Administrative Law Judge Jeffrey A. Watson on October 10, 2019, Metropolitan Edison Company ("Met-Ed" or "Company") submits this letter as a status report in the above-referenced matter. By letter dated November 1, 2019, the Complainant has submitted her anticipated witness list. Met-Ed is in the process of reviewing to determine whether additional discovery will be issued in accordance with the Interim Order issued October 10, 2019.

Ms. Fiedler has not advised regarding her preference of hearing format nor provided her and her witnesses' availability for a hearing as required by the Interim Order. Met-Ed requests that the evidentiary hearing be scheduled as an in-person hearing. Further, Met-Ed's counsel and witnesses are all available on the following upcoming dates for such an in-person hearing: January 9, 16, 21 or 24; and February 3, 5 or 7, 2020. To the extent consecutive days are required, the Company can offer several of its witnesses on January 17, 22, or 23 and February 4, 2020 as well. Finally, the Company believes that given the number of experts anticipated to testify in this matter, it would be appropriate to require the submission of preserved testimony in advance of the evidentiary hearings. To that end, Met-Ed proposes that a deadline of December 20, 2019 for the submission of direct testimony and exhibits, and January 17, 2020 for the submission of rebuttal testimony and exhibits.
