

IMPROPER HANDLING OF CONFIDENTIAL INFORMATION

Dear Secretary Chiavetta,

On November 22, 2019 I mailed to your office, by first-class mail, a true copy of my **Revised Identification of Factual and Expert Witnesses**. I received a PUC Subscription Notice on November 27, 2019 that my results had changed. I went to the site to review the change and your office had filed the **Summary of Expected Witness Testimony** which contained confidential information. I filed this information *properly* at the PUC website before mailing it on November 22, 2019, as no confidential information was included in the filing.

As pro se, I try to follow PUC guidelines as best as I can. I understood I was to put confidential information into an envelope marked "confidential." I thought perhaps I had not done this step, until I opened up the PUC's filing and saw a copy of the confidential envelope I had prepared for the factual witness' confidential report.

Furthermore, the Factual Witness' testimony had "CONFIDENTIAL" typed at the top and someone at the Secretary's Bureau had stamped "CONFIDENTIAL" and the date received. Even so, this confidential information was filed for public view on the PUC website.

Therefore, I am requesting this information be removed immediately from the PUC website. Please advise me when this removal is complete.


