I have video to show proof of the fact that my heat wasn't working the reason I called to begin with. And also I have a video of my final walk through. Like I stated before I never got a final bill or a corrected bill of \$1900 some odd dollars like Mr. Jose said I received. I'm not understanding the statute

of limitations that you're talking about. I further disputed PGW's claim back then; hence how I was able to have it removed from my credit prior to purchasing my home. Now that I bought my home is when PGW is trying to convince me that I owe a bill that wasn't mine to begin with. Lastly I ~~would~~ would like to reiterate that I have never lived in the first floor apt. And there were months my newborn and I didn't have heat due to issues ~~with~~ on the behalf of the landlord and PGW.
