Dear Secretary Chiavetta:

In accordance with the Interim Order issued on May 24, 2019 in the above-referenced matter, this letter serves as a status report on behalf of Metropolitan Edison Company ("Met-Ed" or "Company"). Mr. Faut has failed to participate in the above-referenced proceeding at every turn. Specifically, he has failed to provide responses to the Company's discovery requests, failed to provide notification of his anticipated witnesses, failed to appear at the prehearing conference and failed to provide written direct testimony. Further, Mr. Faut has been non-responsive to the Company's efforts to reach him to discuss the scheduling of an evidentiary hearing in accordance with the Interim Order. As such, Met-Ed respectfully requests that its Motion to Dismiss, as filed on August 23, 2019, be granted.

To the extent that an evidentiary hearing moves forward in this matter, Met-Ed currently expects that Mr. Faut will not present any testimony other than his own; if so, the Company will only present the testimony of one witness. In that case, it is believed that a one-day telephonic hearing would be sufficient to conclude the evidentiary hearings in this matter. Because the Company's counsel and witnesses are already booked for the entire month of December in evidentiary hearings for other matters, Met-Ed proposes that the hearing be set for January 2020, on one of the following dates: January 13, 17, 22, 23, 27, 29, 30 or 31.


