Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission Business Practices

Quality Assurance Plan – Marketing Standards Training

Each year, during month of January, our manager of Regulatory affairs will review the PA UBP's current marketing standards.

Each marketing representative will be trained on:

- Pennsylvania Uniform Business Practices.
- EnergyMark Products and Services.
- EnergyMark rates, payment options, customer cancellation rights, and early termination fees.
- Toll Free contact number for billing questions, disputes, and complaints.
- In Person Customer Contact Rules:
 - > Display Badge, Identify as an independent energy marketer, and representative of EnergyMark.
 - > State that if customer purchases natural gas from EnergyMark, the customer's utility will continue to deliver their natural gas and will respond to any leaks or emergencies.
 - ➤ Never represent that representative is an employee or representative of the utility company.
 - Leave the premises when requested to do so by customer.
 - > Provide customer with written information regarding EnergyMark.
 - > If there is a language barrier, EnergyMark representative will find a person in the area who is fluent in the customer's language or terminate the in-person contact with the customer.
- Telephone Customer Contact Rules:
 - > Provide the representative's first name and, on request, their identification number.
 - State the call is being made on behalf of EnergyMark.
 - > State the purpose of the telephone call.

- > Remove Customer's name from EnergyMark marketing database upon Customer's request.
- ➤ Never represent that EnergyMark is an employee or representative of the utility company.
- ➤ If there is a language barrier, EnergyMark representative will transfer the customer to a representative who speaks the customer's language, if available, or terminate the call.

• EnergyMark and its marketing representatives shall:

- Not engage in misleading or deceptive conduct as defined by State or Federal law, or by Commission rule, regulation or Order.
- > Not make false or misleading representations including misrepresenting rates or savings offered by EnergyMark.
- ➤ Provide the customer with written information, upon request, or with a website address at which information can be obtained, if the customer requests such information via the internet.
- ➤ Use reasonable efforts to provide accurate and timely information about products and services.
- Ensure that any product or service offerings that are made by EnergyMark contain information written in plain language that is designed to be understood by the customer.
- > Investigate customer inquiries and complaints concerning marketing practices within 5 business days of receipt of the complaint.
- ➤ Cooperate with the PA PUC regarding marketing practices proscribed by the Uniform Business Practices and with local law enforcement in investigations concerning deceptive marketing practices.

Dispute Resolution:

 EnergyMark employees are trained to handle customer complaints and resolving disputes arising from marketing activities and shall respond promptly to complaints forwarded by the PA PUC.

The Applicant acknowledges that failure to pay such taxes or otherwise comply with the taxation requirements of Chapter 28, shall be cause for the Commission to revoke the license of the Applicant. The Applicant acknowledges that it shall report to the Commission its jurisdictional Gross Receipts and power sales for ultimate consumption, for the previous year or as otherwise required by the Commission. The Applicant also acknowledges that it is subject to 66 Pa. C.S. §506 (relating to the inspection of facilities and records).

As provided by 66 Pa. 
