Umbriac Trucking LLC ("Respondent") has paid, in full, its outstanding assessment balance for the July 1, 2017 to June 30, 2018 Fiscal Year ("2017-2018 Fiscal Year") and the civil penalty to resolve the above-docketed complaint without litigation.

On November 12, 2019, the Commission received a money order from Respondent in the amount of \$312, which constitutes payment of Respondent's outstanding assessment balance for the 2017-2018 Fiscal Year in the amount of \$12, as well as \$300 related to the civil penalty for Respondent's failure to timely pay the Commission's assessment and file an assessment report demonstrating its gross intrastate revenues earned during the 2016 calendar year.


