**Re: Affiliated Interest Agreement between PECO Energy Company, Delmarva Power & Light, and Atlantic City Electric

Dear Secretary Chiavetta:

By Secretarial Letter issued on October 9, 2019, the Commission approved the above-noted affiliate arrangement and stated that: "PECO is required to provide a fully executed copy of this Agreement to the Commission within 30 days from the date of this Secretarial Letter." On November 7, 2019, PECO filed a status update in which it stated that the transaction was still under review by the New Jersey Board of Public Utilities and that, pending completion of that evaluation, PECO and its affiliates had not executed a written copy of the Agreement. PECO concluded that, if the executed Agreement is not available for filing by January 10, 2020, PECO would file an additional written status update at that time.

The transaction was approved by the New Jersey Board of Public Utilities on or about December 20, 2019. The parties subsequently executed the Agreement and are in the process of publicly recording the Agreement and related documents with county real estate officials. We expect the public recordation to be complete in the next several weeks and, once those documents are publicly recorded, PECO will provide a copy to the Commission in this docket. If for any reason the publicly-recorded Agreement is not available by February 10, 2020, PECO will file an additional status update at that time.
