Dear Secretary Chiavetta:

In accordance with the Interim Order issued on December 20, 2019 in the above-referenced matter, this letter serves as a status report on behalf of West Penn Power Company ("West Penn"). Mr. and Mrs. Pavlick have continuously failed to provide notification of their expert and factual witnesses in accordance with prior Interim Orders. West Penn timely provided notice of its expert and factual witnesses and have failed to provide complete responses to the Company's discovery requests even after the entry of a Protective Order.

As such, West Penn anticipates that the Complainants will not be presenting testimony in this matter or, if they do, it will be limited to their own factual testimony at the time of any evidentiary hearing. Therefore, West Penn anticipates that it will only need to present one witness, Mr. John Ahr, in order to rebut any factual testimony offered at that time. Further, counsel for West Penn believes that the evidentiary hearing can be concluded in one day.

Counsel for West Penn has conferred with Mr. and Mrs. Pavlick regarding the scheduling of an evidentiary hearing. The parties have agreed to a telephonic hearing. Of the dates provided by Your Honor in the Interim Order, the parties and their witnesses are collectively only available for a hearing on March 24, 2020. Counsel for the Company and its witnesses are also available on March 2, 4, 9, 19, 23-24, or 30, 2020.


