Dear Judge Rainey





This is my response to Judge Jeffrey A Watson

I am following my Dr's orders Dr. William Kracht DO  
in that I need until Jan 31st 2020 to answer Complainant  
Interrogatories again. In May of 2019 I did my best of my  
ability to answer the questions then.

I had many psychosocial events that happened in 2019 that  
exacerbated my diseases which are overlapping and a struggle  
just to do minimal activities of daily living.

I have been disabled from my nursing career since Aug of 2008

I have been of formal disability through Social Security since  
2010 after a hearing in Dec of 2009. Starting Feb of 2010.

I had a career as a Nurse at the County Home of Berks County  
Berks Home due to Fibromyalgia, Chronic Fatigue Immune Dysfunction  
Disease, Chronic migraines and headaches, Hypothyroidism and Chronic  
Lyme Disease, Chronic Insomnia.

My illness has not improved and has been reevaluated by Social Security  
routinely. I have been continued to be found to be disabled multiple times  
and review since 2010. Usual basic daily living Activities of Daily living  
for me are very complicated due to trouble concentration wise, chronic sleep  
problems, Gastrointestinal problems, eating chronic nausea and pain over my  
whole body. Chemical Sensitivity and Chronic comorbid fatigue persist  
as medical problems. Electromagnetic Sensitivity persists.

This year I have had these events to exacerbate these chronic issues  
Starting with Jan 6, 2019 (1) The death of my father.

(2) A Car accident May 23 2019 in which I was sitting at a Red  
light at traffic light for which I was treated medically until Nov. end of  
month. I suffered severe back pain whiplash low back and hip  
pain and pain continues.


(3) I had storm damage to my home in May 2019. That noisy and →
