
Dear Secretary Chiavetta:

In accordance with the Interim Order issued on December 13, 2019 in the above-referenced matter, which provided a final extension of time in order for Mr. Maloney to provide responses to discovery as well as notification of anticipated witnesses and providing additional time in order for Mr. Maloney to respond to the Motion to Dismiss which was filed by Metropolitan Edison Company ("Met-Ed" or the "Company"), this letter serves as Met-Ed's status report. To date, the Company has received partial responses to its discovery requests. In an effort to secure more thorough responses from Mr. Maloney, Met-Ed intends to pursue a protective agreement. Met-Ed notes that upon its further review, it found that the partial responses it has received were in fact issued on September 18, 2019; however, Mr. Maloney has consistently failed to follow procedural rules in providing proper service as required under the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission's regulations, instead only sending correspondence and filings to Met-Ed via electronic mail. Further, he continues to not confirm those witnesses he intends to present.

As such, Met-Ed believes that a brief prehearing conference for purposes of setting dates for written testimony and confirming the Complainant's intent with respect to the presentation of witnesses in this matter so that this case can expeditiously move forward would be beneficial, and respectfully requests that one be scheduled.


