Dear Mr. Shalish:

This letter is to remind Philly Limo Inc. ("Philly Limo") of an opportunity to satisfy the above-docketed Complaint for failure to maintain evidence of liability insurance with the Commission.

As stated in I&E's settlement letter dated July 23, 2019, I&E presented Philly Limo an opportunity to pay a reduced civil penalty of \$250 in order to resolve this matter. However, payment was not received within the time requested. Even so, I&E will provide Philly Limo an additional ten (10) days to pay the reduced civil penalty of \$250 in order to satisfy the Complaint. If Philly Limo agrees to amicably resolve this matter by paying the \$250 reduced penalty, a cashier's check or money order in the amount of \$250 and made payable to "Commonwealth of Pennsylvania" should be forwarded to me. Upon receipt of this payment, the Complaint will be closed.

Should Philly Limo elect not to pay the reduced civil penalty as satisfaction of the Complaint within ten (10) days, I will have this matter immediately reassigned to the Commission's Office of Administrative Law Judge and the matter will move forward to an evidentiary hearing wherein the original, larger civil penalty will be sought and Philly Limo's Certificate of Public Convenience could be cancelled. Also, the Complaint could be amended to include additional violations and associated fines. Finally, pursuant to 52 Pa. Code §§ 1.21 and 1.22, should this matter proceed to a hearing, the Company is required to be represented by an attorney at the hearing, which will require incurring those additional legal costs as well.
