

Re: Compliance Filing of CleanChoice Energy, Inc. d/b/a CleanChoice Energy d/b/a Ethical Electric d/b/a Clean Energy Option to maintain its reduced EGS bonding/security requirements (Docket A-2012-2308371, Utility Code 1114741)

Dear Secretary,

1. CleanChoice Energy, Inc. ("CleanChoice") is an EGS in good standing, licensed effective September 13, 2012 in Docket A-2012-2308371 (under its original name of Ethical Electric Benefit Co. d/b/a Ethical Electric, amended to Ethical Electric, Inc. d/b/a Ethical Electric d/b/a Clean Energy Option by the name change filed on November 22, 2013 and approved by Secretarial Letter issued January 3, 2014, and as amended to CleanChoice Energy, Inc. d/b/a CleanChoice Energy d/b/a Ethical Electric d/b/a Clean Energy Option by the name change filed on June 27, 2016 and approved by Secretarial Letter issued September 6, 2016).
2. By Final Order entered July 24, 2014, the Pennsylvania Public Utilities Commission ("Commission") held that an EGS, following its first year of operations, may petition to have its bonding requirement reduced from 10% to 5% of the EGS's last 12 months of revenue or \$250,000, whichever is greater. *Public Utility Commission Bonding/Security Requirements for Electric Generation Suppliers: Acceptable Security Instruments*, Docket No. M-2013-2393141 (Order entered July 24, 2014) ("Bond Reduction Order"). The Financial Security 5% Renewal Process was modified pursuant to Tentative Opinion and Order dated October 9, 2018, as made final following the comment period as of October 16, 2018, Docket No. P-2017-2608078.
3. CleanChoice most recently submitted a petition to reduce its bonding requirement to 5% of its last 12 months of revenue on January 16, 2019.
4. The Commission granted CleanChoice's petition to reduce its bonding requirement on January 16, 2019. The current financial instruments in place for CleanChoice are a bond and letter of credit.
5. CleanChoice hereby submits its 2019 Annual Compliance Filing for 5% Financial Security Reduction Renewal, and encloses the following attachments:
 - a. Appendix A is CleanChoice's most recent 12 months of gross receipts and the 5% calculation on this total amount.

- b. Appendix B is a Tax Letter of Good Standing for CleanChoice from the Department of Revenue.
- c. Appendix C is CleanChoice's most recent Department of Revenue REV 423 PA Corporation Specialty Tax Estimated Payment form.
- d. Appendix D is CleanChoice's EY 2019 Penn AEPS Compliance Letter.
- e. Appendix E is a Certificate of Service.
- f. Appendix F is CleanChoice Energy's contact information.
- g. Appendix G is the updated original bond.

CleanChoice respectfully requests confidentiality for the gross revenue/receipts included as Appendix A. These figures represent sensitive operational information for CleanChoice. Such information, if it were to become publically available, could harm the competitive and commercial operations of CleanChoice by providing competitors with access to CleanChoice's recent operating information providing direct insight into market position, size, and other closely held proprietary business information. These documents are submitted in an envelope marked "confidential."






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
