**PREHEARING ORDER**

**You must call into the hearing on the scheduled day and time. If you fail to do so, your case will be dismissed. You will not be called by the Administrative Law Judge.**

The parties also are hereby directed to comply with the following requirements:

- 1. YOU MUST SERVE ME DIRECTLY WITH ANY DOCUMENTS THAT YOU FILE IN THIS PROCEEDING. IF YOU SEND ME ANY DOCUMENT OR CORRESPONDENCE, YOU MUST SEND A COPY TO ALL OTHER PARTIES IN THE CASE. THE CURRENT SERVICE LIST IS ATTACHED TO THIS ORDER.**

2. A request for a change of the scheduled hearing date must state the agreement or opposition of other parties, and must be submitted in writing no later than 48 hours prior to the hearing. 52 Pa.Code § 1.15(b). Requests for changes of hearing dates must be sent to me and all parties of record. My correct address is:

If you intend to present any documents or exhibits for my consideration at the hearing, prior to the hearing, send a copy of the exhibits to the undersigned by the above fax number or to email [dheep@phila.gov](mailto:dheep@phila.gov) and provide a copy to the attorney for PECO. Please state the Docket Number on any submissions.

4. This hearing is a formal proceeding and will be conducted in accordance with the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedures.

5. The complainant is responsible for payment of current undisputed bills for service pending the resolution of this complaint. 52 Pa.Code § 56.181. Failure to make payments may result in the termination of utility service.

6. If you, or anyone you plan to call as a witness on your behalf, have a limited ability to speak or understand English or are deaf or hearing-impaired, a qualified interpreter can be provided upon your request. If you want an interpreter, please contact the Scheduling Office at least ten (10) days before the scheduled Prehearing Conference or Hearing to make your request. Scheduling Office: (717) 787-1399. 7. The complainant bears the burden of proof in this proceeding and must establish by a preponderance of the evidence that the utility has committed a violation of the Public Utility Code, an order or regulation issued by the Commission, or the utility's tariff.

**8. THIS COMPLAINT WILL BE DISMISSED IF THE CUSTOMER FAILS TO PARTICIPATE IN THE HEARING AND PRESENT EVIDENCE IN SUPPORT OF THE COMPLAINT.**
