Your Honor:

PPL Electric Utilities Corporation (“PPL Electric” or the “Company”) respectfully requests that the hearing scheduled for February 13, 2020, in the above-captioned proceeding be rescheduled for March 27, 2020, at 1:00 PM, because: (1) one of PPL Electric’s expert witnesses, Dr. Mark Israel, is not available for the hearing on February 13, 2020; and (2) Treasure Hoffman (“Complainant”) has informed counsel for PPL Electric that a potential witness of hers will be out of town on February 13, 2020.

On December 20, 2019, a Notice was issued scheduling the hearing in this case on remand for February 13, 2020. On December 29, 2019, the Complainant sent an email to counsel for PPL Electric, asking whether the Company would agree to her requesting Your Honor to reschedule the hearing and adjust the due dates in the litigation schedule accordingly because, among other things, the Complainant’s potential witness will be out of town on February 13, 2020.

Through the exchange of correspondence, the parties discussed rescheduling the hearing for March 27, 2020, with the due dates in the litigation schedule adjusted as follows:

- Complainant’s statements, reports, and written testimony are due to be served by February 26, 2020;
- PPL Electric’s testimony and exhibits are due to be served by March 12, 2020; and

- Exhibits are due to Your Honor on March 20, 2020.

On January 23, 2020, I sent an email to the Complainant and stated that the proposal was acceptable to PPL Electric, so long as the hearing on March 27, 2020, begins at 1:00 PM. On January 27, 2020, I sent another email following up on the January 23, 2020 email and asking the status of the Complainant making the requested changes to the litigation schedule. On January 29, 2020, I left a detailed voicemail for the Complainant, again following up on the prior emails.


The Complainant never responded to those emails or that voicemail.

In the mail on January 30, 2020, I received a copy of the Complainant's letter dated January 28, 2020, requesting that the hearing be rescheduled for March 27, 2020. However, nothing in the letter mentions the other adjustments to the litigation schedule or the March 27, 2020 hearing needing to start at 1:00 PM.

Accordingly, PPL Electric respectfully requests that: (1) the February 13, 2020 hearing be rescheduled for March 27, 2020, at 1:00 PM; and (2) the due dates in the Prehearing Order be adjusted as described previously.

If that date does not work for Your Honor, or if the Complainant disagrees with the hearing beginning at 1:00 PM on that date, PPL Electric will work with the Complainant to develop some alternative dates for the rescheduled hearing.
