**COMPLAINANT'S STATUS REPORT OF JANUARY 13, 2020**

Complainant Pamela Scott, in accordance with Presiding Administrative Law Judge Jeffrey A. Watson's December 20, 2019 *Interim Order Granting Respondent's Motion to Compel Filed On October 30, 2019* ("December 20 Order"), hereby provides this status report that is due on or before January 20, 2020.

1. As required by the December 20 Order, Complainant on January 11, 2020 served supplemental discovery responses upon counsel for Respondent that were due on or before January 13, 2020. These are referred to as *Complainant's Supplemental Response to Respondent's Discovery Request Nos. 22, 23, and 24*.

2. Complainant filed a Certificate of Service on January 11, 2020 regarding service of the discovery responses ordered by the December 20 Order that was due on or before January 13, 2020.

3. Eight of Complainant's nine witnesses have been precluded from presenting testimony by ALJ Jeffrey A. Watson's October 28, 2019 *Interim Order Granting In Part, Respondent's Motion to Preclude Witnesses Identified In Complainant's List of Potential Witnesses From Testifying*. Complainant and Complainant's sole remaining witness that has not at this time been precluded from presenting testimony have uniform availability for scheduling



of the evidentiary hearing for any two consecutive days within the dates set forth in the December 20 Order with the exception of March 25 (i.e., March 2-5, 11, 12, 16-19, 23, 24). Complainant has not and will not seek to preclude any of Respondent's nine witnesses from testifying.

4. No other deadlines are pending at this time.
