MOTION FOR CONTINUANCE AND CHANGE OF LOCATION

Complainant files this Motion for Continuance and Change of Location for the February 5, 2020 Hearing in Philadelphia. In support of her Motion, Complainant respectively submits the following:

1. At the May 2, 2019 pre-hearing conference, the Honorable Jeffrey Watson, ALJ, stated that the in-person hearing would be held in Harrisburg. Complainant and Respondent, which are both located in Berks County, agreed that Harrisburg is the preferred location for the in-person hearing. Furthermore, the Philadelphia location places an undue burden for both parties since it would require over two hours of travel time, compared to approximately one hour travel to Harrisburg.
2. In addition, Complainant's witnesses are not available on February 5, 2020. Complainant respectively requests that both parties are consulted to re-schedule a mutually agreeable date for the in person hearing.
3. Finally, no one is harmed by the re-scheduling of the hearing.

Complainant respectively requests that the Commission grant a continuance and re-schedule the in-person hearing in Harrisburg.


