I would like to formally file this letter as an EXCEPTIONS to a ruling after a hearing on August 15, 2019 concerning PECO Energy company and myself, Karen Tortorella, 5026 York Road, PO Box 455, Holicong, Pa. 18928. The Docket Number is C-2019-3012082.

**THE COMPLAINT FINDING FACT : 5.**

This Fact states complainant receives \$500.00 per week for one writing assignment. A week after the hearing, the assignment discontinued as the client lost his job in the oil field industry. His name is Kirk Burpee if you need to check this fact out. (206) 380-4953; burpee.kirk@gmail.com

**THE COMPLAINT FINDING FACT: 6.**

The Complainant still receives \$596.00 per month per social security, but her household income has changed. The Complainant will receive \$650.00 for a studio rent attached to the back of her kitchen area of her house for the coming year and it is not rented as of yet. The rent has been reduced due to not finding another tenant at for \$830.00. There is a current ad on Craigslist under my address and it is listed with five other rental agencies at the lower amount. The complainant is not renting a room in her house, at the present time, because of problems with the heating ducts in the room, reducing her income by another \$650.00.

**THE COMPLAINTANT FINDING OF FACT 12:**

**OCTOBER 2019:** In mid-October, a few days after the hearing in Philadelphia, a \$500.00 a week editing job was pulled by a client because he lost his job in the oil industry as stated above. So, my monthly income was unexpectedly reduced by \$1,000.00 that month. He did pay me until mid-October. My monthly income changed to \$1,726.00 counting my S.S. of \$596.00 and a writing assignment of \$300.00, and studio rent collected at \$830.00 as the studio room was still being rented and at \$830.00

**NOVEMBER 2019:** In November 2019, I had my income from my Social security of \$596.00, and my studio apartment rent for \$830.00 I had no writing or editing assignments, so my gross income was \$1,396.00

**DECEMBER 2019:** I was still receiving a Social Security payment of \$596.00, and the rent of room for two people \$700.00 (one time rent situation –mother and son recommended by church for one month stay before they were relocating) and zero money for my studio as the tenant left owing rent and breaking a lease, His rent was \$830.00 per month; So my situation changed and my income was only \$1,296.00.

Complainant Fact Point 7: that I receive \$2,763.00 per month is incorrect. Also, incorrect was Complainant Fact 12. At the time of the BCS decision my income was \$2,583.33.

My income for this month for JANUARY 2020 is not the above stated \$2,583.33 but \$596.00 Social Security, Studio not rented yet and room not being rented upstairs in my home due to heating duct problems. And, I did receive \$300.00 for two editing assignments bringing my month's total so far to \$896.00. I have not rented the studio apartment as of this date, as January is the worst month for renting a studio and I had to reduce it to \$65.00 because of that fact.



I do not have the resources to pay a \$2,400.00 Electric Bill from PECO. I depend on my electricity for my water and lights and my computer for my work and to keep my refrigerator cool. I implore the courts to allow me to return to the \$144.00 per month payment. My monthly income I far less than what is represented on the Judge's ruling Initial Decision papers.

Lack of electricity will cause me to become ill as I have a sinus condition and rheumatoid arthritis and I will become mentally depressed and will be unable to use my computer for editing and writing work which is my profession.

I have to pay my mortgage every month of \$1,553.00. I cannot afford to lose my home. I got my house out of foreclosure in Bucks County, Pa. in 2016.

I am formally writing to say I am applying for an Exceptions consideration... Request for Payment Arrangement and reconsideration of the ruling and change in the ruling and that it be rectified as my financial circumstances do not allow me to make a \$2,400.00 payment, but direct me to make a monthly payment of \$144.00.

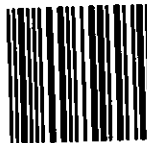
