**SECOND PREHEARING ORDER**

An Initial Call-In Telephonic Hearing is scheduled for **Tuesday, March 3, 2020, at 10:00 a.m.** You must call into the hearing at this time or you may lose your case. You must dial the toll-free bridge number of **1-877-931-1680** and then enter the PIN number of **55872942** followed by the pound sign (#) in order to call into the hearing. The parties are also directed to comply with the following requirements:

1. If you intend to present any documents for my consideration, you must mail one copy to each other party, and mail three copies to me at least five (5) days prior to the date of the hearing. Note that attachments to your Complaint are not admitted into the record unless submitted separately in accordance with this paragraph. Exhibits should be pre-marked for identification at the hearing.

2. If you are an individual, you may either represent yourself or have an attorney licensed to practice law in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania represent you. You are not required to have a lawyer to represent you in the complaint process before the Public Utility Commission.

3. If you are a partnership, corporation, trust, association, joint venture, other business organization, trust, trustee, legal representative, receiver, agency, governmental entity,

municipality or other political subdivision, you must have an attorney licensed to practice law in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania represent you in this proceeding.

4. Unless you are an attorney, you may not represent someone else.

Attorneys shall comply with the Commission's appearance requirements. 52 Pa. Code § 1.24(b). References to the Pa. Code may be accessed at [www.pacode.com](http://www.pacode.com).

5. A request for a change of the scheduled hearing date should be submitted in writing no later than five (5) days prior to the hearing. 52 Pa. Code § 1.15(b). The requesting party must contact the other party to determine whether there is agreement to the change prior to contacting the presiding officer. Requests for changes of the scheduled hearing date must be sent to me with copies to all parties of record. My address is:

Requests for changes to the scheduled hearing date are granted only where good cause exists.

6. **YOU MAY LOSE THIS CASE IF YOU DO NOT TAKE PART IN THIS HEARING AND PRESENT EVIDENCE ON THE ISSUES RAISED.**

7. Although the hearing is being conducted telephonically for the convenience of the parties, this hearing is a formal proceeding and will be conducted in accordance with the Commission's rules of practice and procedure. 52 Pa. Code Chapters 1, 3 and 5.

8. The complainant bears the burden of proving the case and should be prepared to prove claims with testimony and documentary evidence.
