Dear Secretary Chiavetta:

The Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement (“I&E”) of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (“PUC” or “Commission”) files this Petition to Withdraw the above-docketed Formal Complaint (“Complaint”) against Respondent, Nittany Party Bus Services LLC.

On October 16, 2019, I&E served the Complaint against Respondent for failure to maintain evidence of liability insurance, which carries a five-hundred dollar (\$500) civil penalty. On October 21, 2019, the Commission’s Bureau of Technical Utility Services (“TUS”) noted in the audit history of the docket that: a Form E evidence of the Respondent’s liability insurance was received on September 27, 2019; the evidence of insurance was not logged properly with the Commission, and; the Respondent’s insurance did not lapse. Subsequent correspondence between I&E and TUS confirmed that Respondent did maintain evidence of insurance with the PUC and the Respondent’s insurance never lapsed.

Because Respondent’s insurance was properly placed on file with the PUC and did not lapse, I&E has determined that the Complaint against Respondent for failing to maintain evidence of insurance was generated in error. Accordingly, I&E submits this petition to withdraw the above-docketed Complaint against Respondent.

A copy of this letter has been served on Respondent in accordance with the attached Certificate of Service. Pursuant to 52 Pa. Code § 5.94(a), Respondent may object to this Petition within twenty (20) days of service. **If Respondent, Nittany Party**

**Bus Services LLC., does not object to the withdrawal of the above-docketed Complaint then Respondent does not need to take further action.**


