Pursuant to 52 Pa. Code §5.24(b), the Philadelphia Gas Works (PGW) certifies that the above referenced Complaint has been satisfied. PGW and the Complainant have discussed the issues raised in the complaint and has satisfied the complaint on October 11, 2016. With this discussion, the Complainant has indicated that he is satisfied with the resolution of this complaint. This matter was settled on October 11, 2016. Regrettably, the original Certificate of Satisfaction was filed under an incorrect Docket Number and was not entered into the Commission's Docket entries as "Settled/Satisfied." To my knowledge, Mr. Fleming did not object to the settlement in 2016. (See the attached settlement documents.) Dear Mr. Fleming:

Pursuant to our settlement conference, held on October 11, 2016 with the assistance of Administrative Law Judge Jeffrey A. Watson, this letter confirms, the terms of the settlement of the above captioned matter.

In complete settlement of all issues in this matter, you have discussed your concerns with your account with PGW. The parties acknowledge and agree to the following:

1. This matter is a dispute of a bill for Unauthorized Usage in the amount of \$13,137.07 at your residence, 2571 Trenton Avenue, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, **PGW Account No. 359050759** (Service Address). This amount represents 7,592 CCF of gas used during the period from July 16, 2007 through March 2, 2016.
2. You have lived at the Service Address since 2004. PGW terminated gas service to the Service Address for nonpayment in July 2007.
3. For restoration of gas service PGW will accept the full payment of \$13,260.30. This represents the Unauthorized Usage amount of \$13,137.07 and the PGW Reconnection Fee of \$123.23.
4. You will pay \$150 per month until the cost to restore gas service to the Service Address is paid in full. This is \$150 per month for 88 months, then a payment of \$60.30 on the 89th month). After full payment is made you may make an appointment for the restoration of gas service to the Service Address.
