TUS-1            Reference the Agreement, First Sentence. Please provide a detailed description of the methodology used to determine the dollar amount to be paid by PPL Electric.


A.1              The cost was determined through negotiations between PPL Project and Construction personnel and the Damascus Township Supervisors. Damascus Township procured a repair estimate from a local contractor, following which a meeting was held with PPL to review the current age and condition of the area to be repaired. PPL Electric is familiar with current construction costs in the area and determined that the estimate provided by the Township was reasonable. Once all terms were agreed to, the proportional amount to be paid by PPL was determined and agreed upon by both parties. This is the amount for which PPL is currently seeking PUC approval (\$11,982.87).
