MOTION FOR A CONTINUANCE

Pursuant to 52 Pa. Code § 5.103 and 52 Pa. Code §1.15, Respondent Duquesne Light Company (“Duquesne Light”) files this Motion for a Continuance:

1. On November 25, 2019 Complainant filed a Formal Complaint (“Complaint”) against Duquesne Light regarding his residential account for electric service located at 1210 Holmes Street, McKees Rocks, PA 15136.
2. By Prehearing Order, dated February 12, 2020, a telephonic hearing for the above-captioned matter was scheduled for March 6, 2020.
3. The undersigned attorney representing Duquesne Light in the above-referenced proceeding will be on vacation and unavailable on March 6, 2020.
4. Further, the fact witness for Duquesne Light in the above-referenced proceeding will be on vacation and unavailable from April 2, 2020 through and including April 13, 2020.
5. The Prehearing Order stated, “[a] request for a change of the scheduled hearing date must state the agreement or opposition of the other parties and must be submitted in writing no later than five days prior to the hearing” (emphasis in original).
6. This filing is being submitted more than five days prior to the scheduled hearing.
7. Attempts to contact the Complainant using the telephone number listed on the Complaint on February 18, 2020 and February 19, 2020, were unsuccessful.

8. Duquesne Light has been unable to reach Complainant to obtain his consent to reschedule the hearing.

WHEREFORE, Duquesne Light Company respectfully requests that the Commission grant its Motion for a Continuance and reschedule the hearing on a date after March 9, 2020 to ensure the availability of the Company's attorney.


