Dear Secretary Chiavetta:

In accordance with the Interim Order issued on December 31, 2019 in the above-referenced matter, this letter serves as a status report on behalf of Metropolitan Edison Company ("Met-Ed"). Ms. Ott has continued to fail to provide notification of her expert and factual witnesses in accordance with the Interim Order and the others that preceded it. Met-Ed timely provided notice of its expert and factual witnesses and avers that discovery between the parties is now complete.¹

As such, Met-Ed anticipates that the Complainant will not be presenting testimony in this matter or, if she does, it will be limited to her own factual testimony at the time of any evidentiary hearing. Therefore, Met-Ed anticipates that it will only need to present one witness, Mr. John Ahr, in order to rebut any factual testimony offered at that time.

Counsel for Met-Ed has conferred with counsel for Ms. Ott regarding the scheduling of an evidentiary hearing. The Parties have agreed to a telephonic hearing. Unfortunately, the sole date in April that all counsel and witnesses are available for a hearing is April 24, 2020.
