In response to Ms. McCarthy's Motion to Dismiss Metropolitan Edison Company's ("Met-Ed") Objections to the Interrogatories of Noreen McCarthy (Set II) as filed on February 26, 2020, Met-Ed avers that Ms. McCarthy's allegation that Met-Ed's objections were untimely is incorrect. Ms. McCarthy served her Set II Interrogatories upon counsel for Met-Ed on February 6, 2020. Objections to interrogatories were due within ten days of service, making Met-Ed's objections due February 16, 2020, which was a Sunday. Further, Monday, February 17, 2020, was a federal and Commonwealth holiday. As such, per the terms of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission's regulations at 52 Pa.
