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### GRANT OF RIGHT-OF-WAY

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That PENN FOREST TOWNSHIP, a municipal corporation of Pennsylvania hereinafter called "GRANTOR", intending to be legally bound, does hereby for itself and its successors and assigns grant unto **PPL ELECTRIC UTILITIES CORPORATION ("PPL")**, its successors and assigns, the right to construct, reconstruct, operate and maintain its electric and communication facilities consisting of one (1) pole, overhead and underground facilities as shown on the plan hereto attached and made a part hereof including such other wires, cables, fixtures and apparatus necessary for the convenient transaction of the business of PPL("PPL Facilities"), upon, across, over, under and along the property identified as County Tax Parcel No. 36-51-A8.20 which the undersigned owns or has any interest located along SR 903 situate in the Township of Penn Forest, County of Carbon, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania("Property"); including the right of ingress and egress to and from the said lines for any of the aforesaid purposes; also the right to cut down any and all trees within five (5) feet each side of centerline of the electric/communication line and the right to trim any and all trees within five (5) feet each side of centerline of the electric/communication line and to remove brush along said lines which in the judgment of said PPL menace the said lines; and also the right to permit the attachment of wires and cables of any other person or company to said poles ("Other Facilities"): provided however, any such Other Facilities shall be substantially the same in physical form, appearance, and function as, and of no greater burden, encumbrance or disturbance to the Property than the PPL Facilities. Any poles or facilities erected hereunder along a highway, whether within or outside the highway limits, may be relocated at PPL's expense to conform to new or relocated highway limits; provided, however, PPL must obtain Grantor's consent to such relocation, which consent shall not be unreasonable withheld, and such relocation shall neither cause, result in, or necessitate the relocation or removal of any buildings or structures located on the Property at the time of such relocation, nor cause or create any greater burden, encumbrance or disturbance to the Property. PPL shall restore the Property to substantially the same condition that the Property was in prior to installation, maintenance, relocation or repair of either PPL Facilities or Other Facilities.

A copy of this agreement and an acceptance hereof by PPL shall be filed by PPL with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission, and this agreement shall thereafter become effective in accordance with the provisions of the Public Utility Law.



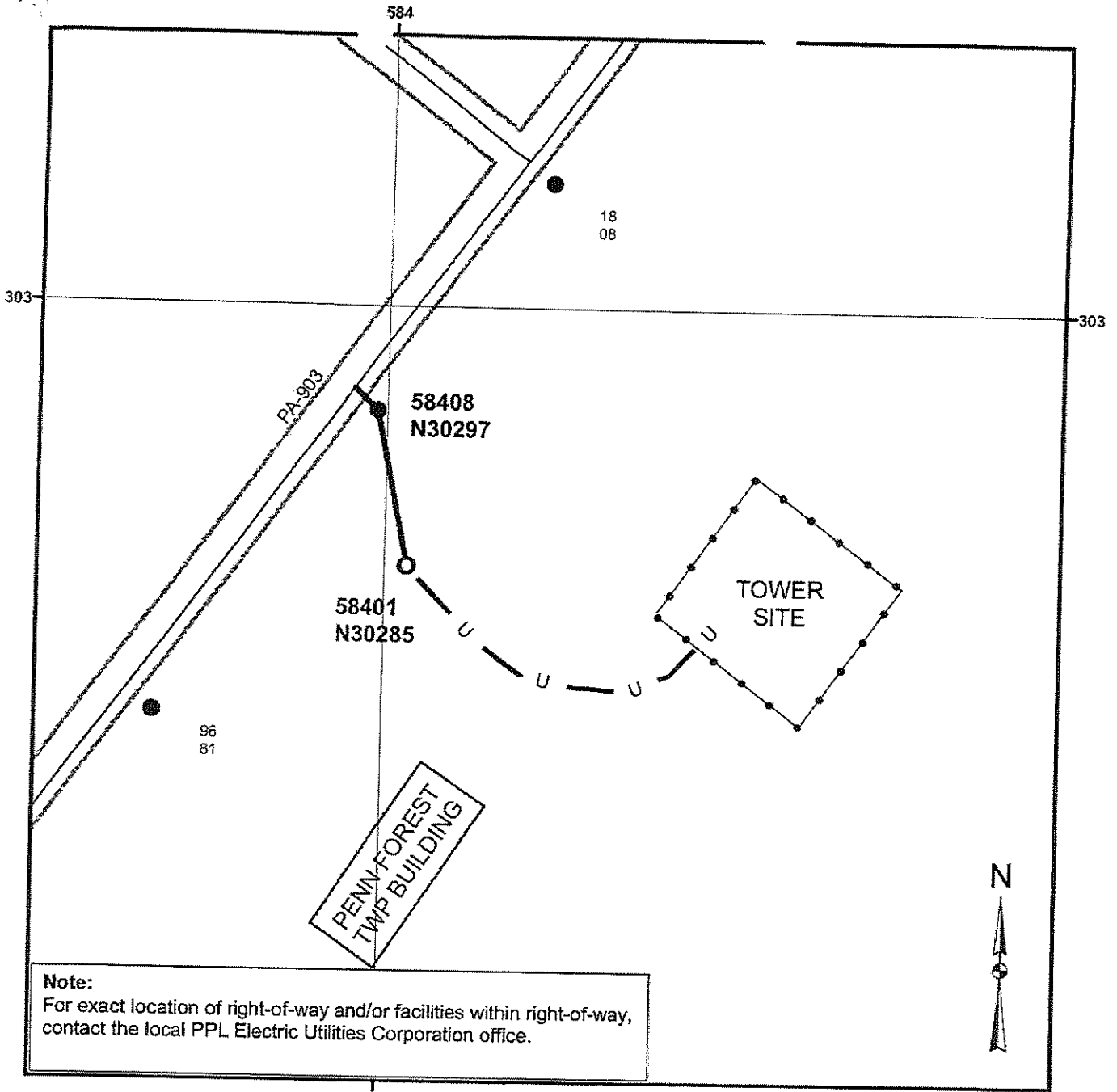
