On October 8, 2019, Chevron Appalachia, LLC ("Chevron") submitted an application through the eFiling online system for approval to alter a crossing located in Luzerne Township, Fayette County, Pennsylvania (DOT #367 800 C). The alteration would have involved the installation of a three-metal clad multi conductor armored cables where T-305 crosses under the tracks of Norfolk Southern Railroad Company.

Chevron would like to withdraw the PUC application because it has decided to suspend indefinitely the oil and gas development operations that the alteration was intended to support. This letter will serve as notice to the Pennsylvania Utility Commission that the application (Docket # A-2019-3013638) can be formally withdrawn.
