MOTION FOR CONTINUANCE OF HEARING DATE

PECO Energy Company ("PECO"), pursuant to 52 Pa. Code § 1.15(b), hereby requests a continuance of the hearing date scheduled in this matter and states the following:

1. An in-person hearing for this matter is scheduled to take place on Thursday, March 12, 2020 at 10:00 AM.
2. PECO is requesting a continuance of the March 12th hearing date because PECO is unable to conduct a field visit prior to the hearing. Specifically, Ms. Meade is unable to take off time from work before March 12th to provide access to her property so that her allegations of overcharge and potential foreign wiring may be investigated. Without a proper inspection prior to the hearing, the effectiveness and productivity of the hearing will be undermined.
3. PECO therefore respectfully requests that the hearing be continued to a further date.
4. The Prehearing Order in this matter states that requests for a continuance are only granted "in rare situations where good cause exists." (Prehearing Order, citing 52 Pa. Code § 1.15).

5. PECO avers that “good cause” exists to continue the scheduled hearing to another date because Ms. Meade’s work schedule precludes PECO from conducting an inspection of the property prior to the hearing.

6. PECO has contacted Ms. Meade, and she consented to a continuance.

7. PECO respectfully requests that the further hearing be continued to a further date.
