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## RULES & REGULATIONS

1. Advance reservations are required and must be made two (2) hours prior to service being rendered. Any reservation made less than two (2) hours to travel time will be charged an additional fee.
2. Rates for mileage are determined by the odometer of the vehicle in use and begin when the vehicle leaves the passenger's premises. The final mileage reading is determined upon drop-off of the passenger.
3. Additional expenses necessitated by or incurred at the request of the passengers, including but not limited to, highway tolls, bridge tolls, entrance fees and parking, shall be added to the charge of the trip. Expenses for driver's lodging and meals while on trips out of town which are in excess of ten (10) hours will be added to the basic charge.
4. If any trip requires the vehicle and driver to remain at a destination overnight, or at any point en route to a destination overnight, the patron will be responsible for providing carrier's driver with accommodations at an overnight facility (motel, hotel) being utilized by the patron, and all meals required by the carrier's driver. Expenses for driver's lodging and meals while on trips out of town which are in excess of ten (10) hours will be added to the basic charge.
5. **CONTRACT SERVICES**  
Contract services will be for a term of not less than 30 days for pre-qualified persons under a federal, state, county or municipal government agency contract. Rates for the services will be specified in the respective contracts, copies of which, including any amendments thereto, are to be filed with the Commission as executed to become effective on one day's notice.

(Per Person)

Flat Rates – For all loaded miles from the point of pickup to point of drop-off

WHEELCHAIR VAN: Standard Hours: 12:01 AM to 11:59 PM

Wheelchair Van One Way: \$ 40.00

Wheelchair Van Round Trip: \$ 60.00

Wheelchair Van Mileage rate: \$1.50 per mile, or any fraction thereof, applies in addition to the Flat Rate stated above on all loaded miles, after the first five (5) miles up to twenty (20) miles, \$2.00 per mile applies to miles (twenty) 20 and over from the point of pick-up to the final destination for Wheelchair Van.

Flat Rates- For all loaded miles from the point of pickup to point of drop-off

STRETCHER VAN: Standard Hours: 12:01 AM to 11:59 PM

Stretcher Van One Way: \$ 90.00

Stretcher Van Round Trip: \$135.00

Stretcher Van Mileage rate: \$2.00 per mile, or any fraction thereof, applies to the Flat Rate stated above on all loaded miles from the point of pickup to the final destination for Stretcher Van.

Reservations: Any Reservation made less than two (2) hours before travel time will be charged an additional \$25.00 fee.

Waiting Time At Origin: After the first sixty (60) minutes of free time the passenger will be charged at the rate of \$20.00 for every sixty (60) minute increment, or any fraction thereof.
