In support of its motion, PGW states as follows:


1. On or about January 14, 2020, PGW was served with the Complaint filed in the above captioned matter, which is a request for reimbursement for the cost of a house heater at the Complainants' residence located at 6612 N. 20th Street, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania ("Service Address").
2. On February 3, 2020, PGW filed its Answer to the Complaint.
3. By the Commission's Notice dated February 4, 2020, this matter has been set for an Initial In-Person Hearing on Tuesday, March 17, 2020 at 10:00 a.m.
4. Due to the advised coronavirus precautions to be taken regarding "social distancing" at the current time, PGW request that the hearing of this matter be continued to a future date.




