Dear Secretary Chiavetta:

In accordance with the Interim Order issued on March 6, 2020 in the above-referenced matter, this letter serves as a status report on behalf of Metropolitan Edison Company (“Met-Ed”). In accordance with that Interim Order, the parties have exchanged discovery in this proceeding. However, Mr. and Mrs. Kramer failed to provide notification of their expert and factual witnesses. Witness identification has been made only by Met-Ed.

As such, Met-Ed anticipates that Mr. and Mrs. Kramer will not be presenting testimony in this matter or, if they do, it will be limited to their own factual testimony at the time of any evidentiary hearing. Therefore, Met-Ed anticipates that it will only need to present one witness, Mr. John Ahr, in order to rebut any factual testimony offered at that time.

Counsel for Met-Ed was able to reach Mrs. Kramer via electronic mail. However, Mrs. Kramer refused to provide any availability for hearing or to discuss their preference in hearing format in contradiction to the Interim Order of March 6, 2020. Further, Mrs. Kramer stated that the Complainants would be providing their own status report which would explain that they have not been provided with “due process so it is inappropriate timing.” Given the lack of meaningful response from Mrs. Kramer, Met-Ed requests that a one-day telephonic evidentiary hearing be scheduled. Counsel for Met-Ed and its witness are available as follows in June 2020: June 2, 4-5, 8-11, 17, 19, 22-26, and 29, 2020.
