I am trying to settle a "complaint" filed against our company, Monolith Trucking LLC. Our authority was voluntarily revoked by us. The truck was in a serious accident on 5/2/19. It took a long time to process the claim and have the truck repaired. Consequently, we had to sell the trailer and lost our only customer. As of 2/27/2020 by decision of the US Dept of Transportation, FMCSA accepted our voluntary revocation of authority. Our insurance was properly cancelled because the truck is out of service. We were never told that there were any procedures to follow to shut down the PUC. I hope this clears up this matter. Please let me know if you need anything else from us; we really can't afford a \$500+ fine.
