KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that Rush Township, of 15 Earnhardt Lane, Danville, Pennsylvania 17821,

for and in consideration of the sum of Fourteen Thousand Ten Dollars and 00/100 (\$14,010.00) in hand paid by **PPL Electric Utilities Corporation**, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby remise, release, quitclaim and forever discharge the said PPL Electric Utilities Corporation, its respective officers, agents, employees, successors, assigns and all persons or entities, whether or not named herein, who may be jointly or severally liable, of and from all suits, claims, demands, actions, damages and claims for damages or contribution whatsoever arising out of or resulting from any injury, loss or damage that may have been caused to Reed Road and Moser Road, crops, grain, land, and personal property in the Township of Rush, County of Northumberland, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, by reason of the construction, reconstruction and/or maintenance by the said PPL Electric Utilities Corporation of its overhead and/or underground electric line facilities, upon, over, under and across said property to the day of the date of these presents. Owner shall maintain in the strictest confidence the terms of this Agreement, including the amount payable hereunder.

This Agreement is between a public utility and a municipal corporation and is therefore subject to Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission ("PUC") review pursuant to 66 Pa.C.S.A. § 507. The Effective Date of this Agreement shall be the later of I) thirty (30) days from the date that PPL submits the Agreement to the PUC; or II) if the PUC opens an investigation of the Agreement, on the date the PUC approves the Agreement.
