Dear Secretary Chiavetta:

In accordance with the Interim Order issued on February 10, 2020 in the above-referenced matter, this letter serves as a status report on behalf of Metropolitan Edison Company (“Met-Ed”). While the Complainants stated via electronic mail that they *may* have additional witnesses to include one expert and two factual witnesses, the Complainants have continued to fail to provide timely and complete notification of their expert and factual witnesses in accordance with the Interim Order, which provided a deadline of by March 13, 2020. Met-Ed timely provided notice of its expert and factual witnesses and avers that discovery between the parties is now complete.<sup>1</sup> Given the Complainants’ lack of proper notification and summaries, Met-Ed intends to proceed with all witnesses as stated in their notification dated March 13, 2020.

Counsel for Met-Ed has conferred with Ms. Bae regarding the scheduling of an evidentiary hearing. The parties have agreed to a telephonic hearing. The Interim Order stated that the parties should provide their availability for a hearing between April 27, 2020 through May 22, 2020. Given the current situation regarding COVID-19 and that all evidentiary hearings scheduled prior to May 15, 2020 are currently being cancelled and will be rescheduled at a later date, it is believed that the evidentiary hearing for this proceeding may not be able to be scheduled until June or July 2020. To that end, the parties are available for a telephonic hearing as follows: June 8, 9, 29, or 30 or July 14, 16, 28 or 29, 2020.
