

Good morning Parties of Record:

Mr. Paul has now sent me an email which I received this morning and did not come back as undeliverable. Mr. Paul is included on this email so the other Parties now have his correct email address. Attached are the Preliminary Objections filed by Norfolk Southern and by the Borough of Boswell – both filed on April 21, 2020.

It has come to our attention that the Complainant also mentions Westmoreland County in his complaint. Therefore, to ensure due process, my office has attached the original complaint to this email and added to the Parties of Record Ms. Melissa Giddy, the Solicitor of Westmoreland County. Westmoreland County will also be served separately with the complaint today. I am now assigning this matter to the Office of Administrative Law Judge since it is a contested proceeding.

Mr. Paul has ten (10) days – until the close of business on May 1, 2020 - to file a response to the Preliminary Objections. If more time is needed by any Party to respond, or any Party requests mediation, any Party can file for such a request, which will be assigned to the presiding Administrative Law Judge. Please know that the presiding officer will require viable contact information to reach all Parties by telephone or email.

Mr. Paul is correct. This pandemic should not impede the progression of this proceeding before the Commission. That is why the Commission's Emergency Order at M-2020-3019262 requires ALL Parties to open and use efilng accounts to file documents and accept service during the pandemic emergency. If any of the Parties do not have an efilng account, please go to our website at [www.puc.pa.gov](http://www.puc.pa.gov) and sign up for an efilng account free of charge immediately. The only exception is if your filing contains any confidential or proprietary information, you are permitted to email that filing directly to me.
