I am forwarding you a copy of Ms. Umbaugh's e-mail/report dated March 18, 2020. This will correct any ex part communication between Ms. Umbaugh and myself concerning this case.

In her e-mail, Ms. Umbaugh's indicated that she and Mr. Harrington had reached a mutually acceptable agreement with regard to the plans for bringing electricity to her residence. In view of this agreement, Ms. Umbaugh indicated that she no longer intends to pursue her complaint against West Penn Power.

Given this information, I assumed (maybe wrongly) that Mr. Harrington was a West Penn Power representative and a settlement had been reached between the parties. I interpreted Ms. Umbaugh's statement that she "has no desire to proceed with the case at this time" as a request to withdraw her Complaint and was in the process of preparing an Initial Decision granting her request.
