Enclosed for filing on behalf of Columbia Gas of Pennsylvania, Inc. ("Columbia") is Supplement No. 307 to Tariff Gas Pa. P.U.C. No. 9 ("Supplement No. 307"), submitted pursuant to 66 Pa.C.S. § 1308, along with all supporting exhibits, standard data responses, and testimony required to be submitted in conjunction with a tariff change seeking a general rate increase. Supplement No. 307, issued April 24, 2020, to be effective June 23, 2020, changes Columbia's base distribution rates, and removes, revises, and adds various tariff provisions, and is submitted in compliance with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission's ("Commission") regulations, the Commission's Emergency Order at Docket No. M-2020-3019262 and recent directives related to e-Filing documents with the Secretary's Bureau.

On March 24, 2020, Columbia filed a request for a waiver of 52. Pa. Code § 53.52(b)(2) concerning the 120 day time period between the end of an historic test year and the date on which a proposed increase in base rates is filed. Columbia specifically requested a thirty (30) day extension granting it authority to file data in support of a proposed increase in base rates based upon an historic test year ended November 30, 2019, on or before April 28, 2020. On March 27, 2020 the Commission's Bureau of Technical Utility Services ("TUS") granted Columbia's waiver request and as such, Columbia's enclosed filing is submitted on or before April 28, 2020 in accordance with the waiver. Columbia's enclosed filing includes certain rates, such as gas costs (and others), which were in effect at the time of the Company's

originally anticipated filing date of March 20, 2020. Because of the unique timing circumstances, Columbia conferred with TUS to provide an acceptable version of proposed Supplement No. 307 for this filing.

Columbia's filing reflects an overall revenue increase of approximately \$100.4 million per year. Pursuant to the proposed rates in Columbia's filing notice, which includes the most recently effective gas cost rates, the total bill for a residential customer who purchases 70 therms of gas from Columbia per month would increase from \$87.57 to \$103.19 per month, or by 17.84 percent. The total bill for a small commercial customer using 158 therms of gas purchased from Columbia per month would increase from \$145.15 to \$167.77, or by 15.58 percent. The total bill for a small industrial customer using 1,328 therms of gas from Columbia per month would increase from \$994.04 to \$1,124.93 per month, or by 13.17 percent.
