Dear Secretary Chiavetta:

This letter constitutes the status report directed¹ in the above-mentioned complaint proceeding on the efforts to resolve this proceeding.

The parties are continuing to work towards a resolution. At this time, it is anticipated that a full resolution can be worked out.

- All sewer work has been completed.
- All restoration work has been completed. The grassy areas were restored late in 2019 and some areas may need to be reseeded in 2020. Determinations if reseeding is needed will be made by May 31, 2020.
- The Complainants do not wish to agree to a Certificate of Satisfaction until all of the sewer work, and any related-restoration work, is complete to the Complainants' satisfaction.
- At this time, the Complainants have not agreed to the filing of a Certificate of Satisfaction. Prior to this report, The Pittsburgh Water and Sewer Authority ("PWSA" or "Authority") asked that the Complainants state (in writing) their unresolved issues. On

¹ On April 30, 2020, Deputy Chief Administrative Law Judge ("ALJ") Mark A. Hoyer requested that status reports be provided to all parties and e-filed with the Commission's Secretary's Bureau. It was agreed in prior discussion (on or about August 1, 2019) between the ALJ and the parties, that the parties would provide status reports on their efforts to resolve the complaint. Prior status reports (of October 30, 2019 and January 31, 2020) were emailed to the ALJ and the parties.

March 3, 2020, the Complainants provided a list itemizing what, to date, they are aware of that is needed to complete this project. There are 4 items on that list. PWSA responded to those items on March 11, 2020. The Complaints, on March 30, 2020, stated that their issues are still unresolved. PWSA's evaluation of the Complainants' unresolved issues has been slowed due the COVID-19 crisis. PWSA intends to continue its evaluation of the unresolved issues.

PWSA would propose that the next status report be submitted on Friday, July 31, 2020.
