Dear Secretary Chiavetta:

In accordance with the Interim Order issued on October 3, 2019 by ALJ Watson in the above-referenced matter, this letter serves as a status report on behalf of Noreen McCarthy. On March 31, 2020, the above-referenced matter was reassigned to ALJ Johnson and, by notice dated April 23, 2020; an evidentiary hearing has been rescheduled for July 14, 2020.

I apologize that this status report is one day late. Everything in the Litigation Schedule has been accomplished by both parties. I am waiting on replies from ALJ Johnson and/or the PUC regarding the following items 1-2, in addition to a response/request regarding the rescheduled hearing date, item 3:

1. February 18, 2020 I filed a Motion to Stay that I have not received a response from ALJ Johnson.
2. March 30, 2020 I filed a request for the following information: who the Grievance Officer is and his/her contact information and/or who the ADA Coordinator serving the PUC is and instructions on how and where to file my ignored request for ADA accommodations. I also requested information as to which branch of the Supreme Court covers Grievances from Denial of Accommodation by ALJs in PA PUC Formal Complaint Proceedings. I have not received a response from the PUC or ALJ Johnson.
3. April 7, 2020 I filed a letter requesting a 90 day hearing continuance due to the pandemic as per the PUC emergency order of March 20 allows http://www.puc.state.pa.us/about_puc/covid_19.aspx . In addition to the reasons stated in that letter I have scheduling, volunteer, and family commitments that would make it a hardship to attend my hearing on July 14. I will have availability during the first week in August or any date after to accommodate all parties.

I asked for an ALJ reassignment who would take into consideration my disabilities under the ADA and I am at the mercy of his discretion as I await his responses for the above listed items.

The MetEd attorneys are using the PUC process to harass me, which is not permitted under the ADA. I am being wrongly accused because, unlike their accusation, I did email them the answers to their answered interrogatory questions. They are using stock verbiage and should study my case individually, which is a simple manner of checking the case file on the PUC website and their email.
