

SECTION 1  
RULES & REGULATIONS

**ITEM 10 - SCOPE OF CARRIER'S OPERATING AUTHORITY**

To transport, household goods in use, and property traveling between points in Pennsylvania and transported distances of forty (40) miles and less and distances in excess of forty (40) miles.

**ITEM 20 - GOVERNING PUBLICATIONS**

For rates, rules, regulations and provisions applicable to the transportation of household goods, in use, except as otherwise specifically provided herein, see Tariff Freight Pa. P.U.C. No. 53 (Carrier Directory No. 53), loose-leaf revisions thereto and successive issues thereof, issued by Tristate Household Goods Tariff Conference, Inc., Agent.

**ITEM 30 - CLASSIFICATION OF PROPERTY**

Class 1 shipments are personal effects and property used or to be used in a dwelling when a part of the equipment or supply of such dwelling and such other similar property: except that this subparagraph shall not be construed to include property moving from a factory or store, except such property as the householder has purchased with the intent to use in his dwelling and which is transported at the request of, and the transportation charges paid to the carrier by the householder.

**ITEM 40 - DECLARED VALUE**

Rates and charges named herein applicable when the value declared by shipper does not exceed sixty (60) cents per pound, per article. For method of determining rates when declared value exceeds sixty (60) cents per pound, per article, see Governing Tariff.

Abbreviations, reference marks and symbols are explained on last page of tariff.

**SECTION 2**  
**SCHEDULE OF RATES**

**ITEM 200** - Applicable on the transportation of HOUSEHOLD GOODS, IN USE (Item 30) traveling between points in Pennsylvania and transported distances of forty (40) miles and less.

Subject to Notes AA, BB and 1 to 7 below, the transportation charges on any shipment shall be a COMBINATION of the applicable TRAVELING CHARGES named in Column 1 plus the HOURLY CHARGE at applicable rates named in Columns 2, 3 and 4.

Hourly rates apply only from time of arrival of vehicle(s) and men at first point of origin (continue during all loading, transportation from first point of origin to final destination, and unloading) until completion of unloading and dismissal of vehicle(s) and men by shipper at destination. Traveling charges covers traveling from the carrier's terminal to first point of origin and traveling from final destination back to the carrier's terminal.

NOTE 1 - Traveling charge (Column 1) are in addition to hourly rates (Columns 2, 3 and 4)

NOTE 2 - Hourly rates (Columns 2, 3 and 4) are based on the day or days, or period of days, as indicated, during which services are performed.

▲ NOTE 3 - Hourly rates (Columns 2, 3 and 4) computed in one-quarter hour periods; fractions of one-quarter hours considered as one-quarter hour.

NOTE 4 - Minimum transportation charge: Sundays and Holidays (any hour): eight (8) hours at rates named in Columns 1 and 2. Saturdays (any hour) and Weekdays, 6:01PM to 6:00AM: four (4) hours at rates named in Columns 1 and 4.

NOTE 5: Carrier will supply and charge for supervisor(s) as requested by shipper. Hourly rate for each supervisor will be computed from time of arrival of vehicle(s) and men at first point of origin until completion of unloading and dismissal of vehicle(s) and men at final destination unless other time of arrival or dismissal of supervisor is provided by agreement between shipper and carrier.

NOTE 6 - Rates in Column 4 only apply from 6:01PM to 12:00 Midnight on any day that a higher rates is shown for the following day.

▲ NOTE 7 - The traveling charge is based on the actual time required to travel from carrier's terminal to first point of origin and from final destination back to the carrier's terminal. Hourly rate used for travel charge is based on the day or days when services are provided at rates named in Columns 2, 3 or 4 above.

**SECTION 2**  
**SCHEDULE OF RATES**

**▲ FULL VALUE PROTECTION**

When a shipment is moved with Full-Value Protection (FVP) coverage, a value must be declared by the Shipper on the Bill of Lading for the entire shipment. The Full-Value Protection rates shown below apply for distances of forty (40) miles and less and distances over forty (40) miles. The cost of the Full-Value Protection coverage shall be as follows:
