Dear Secretary Chiavetta, Judge Barnes, and Mr. Ryan,

My wife and I are still stuck in the Philippines due to the Covid pandemic. Our original return date was April 9 but our flight was cancelled as I stated in my previous email to you. I have been trying to work with the Embassy in Manila to get a return flight home, but it has been extremely difficult. The people at the Embassy had no idea what kind of tests were required regarding covid and how long it would take to get the necessary clearance to leave on an earlier arranged flight. Many people here were left stranded. The Embassy next arranged for two flights from Manila on Saturday, but now cannot find our application. I am not certain when we will be able to return to the U.S.

We are on an island with my wife's family and are trying to arrange to get to Manilla. I have heard that my case was dismissed. I am officially requesting an indefinite emergency extension of the due date for filing my Exceptions. I have limited access to email and no computer. I will write my Exceptions when I am back in the U.S. and settled.

Please provide me with an emergency extension.
