
Dear Secretary Chiavetta:

I am writing on behalf of our client, CSX Transportation, Inc. ("CSXT"), in regard to PECO's Application filed on April 22, 2020, in the above-referenced matter. CSXT has no objection to PECO's Application or plans. However, as noted in both its Application and plans, CSXT retains the right to reactivate the currently suspended rail-highway crossing at this location, pursuant to the Secretarial Letter dated August 26, 2014, in the proceeding docketed to A-2014-2427308.

PECO's current plans call for open trenching to perform its transmission line work. This is fine, so long as PECO's work precedes CSXT's planned reactivation of this crossing by installing new tracks and a new crossing surface. However, should PECO's current plans to perform its work by the end of 2020 be delayed, or CSXT's reactivation plans and track work be accelerated, following notification to all affected parties and Commission application, PECO will need to modify to a trenchless plan at the crossing.
