In re: Application of the Carnegie Natural Gas Company for approval of an agreement between said company and The Pennsylvania Railroad Company whereby the railroad company grants the gas company the right to construct under its right of way one 36 inch cast steel pipe at a location 1083 feet north of the center of the railroad station in the borough of Duquesne, and one concrete culvert over Thomson's run in said borough, and for approval of the construction of said pipe line and culvert.

MEMORANDUM REPORT

The Carnegie Natural Gas Company, in the present applications, requests approval for the construction of a 36 inch steel pipe in a concrete tunnel under and across the right of way and tracks of the Monongahela division of The Pennsylvania Railroad Company in the borough of Duquesne, Allegheny county, for the purpose of conveying gas from its by-product coke plant at Clairton to the plant of the Carnegie Steel Company at Duquesne. It also asks for the approval of the agreement between the Carnegie Natural Gas Company and The Pennsylvania Railroad Company covering this construction. There is also involved the construction of a concrete culvert for the purpose of carrying the pipe over Thomson's run. Detailed plans for the proposed concrete tunnel and the concrete culvert were filed with the application. Under the agreement the gas company bears all the costs and expense of constructing and maintaining the tunnel, pipe and culvert. It would appear that the only question is whether the construction as proposed is safe. On this question the Bureau of Engineering has filed a report recommending approval in accordance with the plans.

I recommend approval.
